NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF CLASS ACTION

TO: ALL CURRENT AND FORMER HOURLY EMPLOYEES OF WAL-MART STORES, INC. (INCLUDING SAM'S CLUB AND WAL-MART SUPERCENTERS) IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA DURING THE PERIOD MARCH 19, 1998 TO PRESENT.

PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY, IT MAY AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

This is a notification that you are a member of a plaintiff class (the "Class") in this case against Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. (including Sam's Club and Wal-Mart Supercenters) ("Wal-Mart" or "Defendant") in the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas (the "Lawsuit").

The purpose of this Notice is to explain to you:

1. What the Lawsuit is about.
2. Your Rights as a Class Member.
3. Further Court Proceedings.
4. How to Get More Information.

1. **What the Lawsuit is About**

Plaintiffs allege that Wal-Mart has failed to compensate its hourly employees for missed and shorted rest and meal breaks and required its hourly employees to work off-the-clock. Plaintiffs seek monetary damages based on their claims. Wal-Mart has denied and continues to deny the allegations made by Plaintiffs on behalf of the Class, and has asserted many defenses. No final ruling has been made on these claims. The Court has scheduled a trial date for September 5, 2006.

2. **Your Rights as a Class Member**

The Class consists of:

All current and former hourly employees of Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. (including Sam's Club and Wal-Mart Supercenters) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from March 19, 1998 to the present.

The certified Class Representatives are the Plaintiffs, Michelle Braun and Dolores Hummel. The certified Class counsel are the law firms of Donovan Searles, LLC, 1845 Walnut Street, Suite 1100, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19103; Abbey Spanier Rodd Abrams & Paradis, LLP, 212 East 39th Street, New York, New York 10016; Bader & Associates, LLC, 14426 East Evans Avenue, Suite 200, Denver, Colorado 80014; and Franklin D. Azar & Associates, P.C., 14426 East Evans Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80014. These attorneys will represent you as part of the class unless you choose to hire your own attorney. You have the right to hire your own attorney.

If you wish to remain in the Class, **YOU DO NOT NEED TO TAKE ANY ACTION**. If you remain in the Class you will be bound by any decision, favorable or unfavorable, in this case.

If you do not wish to remain in the Class, then you must make your request in writing. If you exclude yourself from the Class, you will not participate in any settlement or favorable judgment in the Lawsuit but you also will not be bound by any unfavorable judgment.

Your request to be excluded from the Class must be in writing and must provide your name and address and a statement that you wish to be excluded from the Class in Braun v. Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. and Hummel v. Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. This statement must be sent by first-class mail, postmarked not later than May 22, 2006 addressed to Class counsel. If you request exclusion on behalf of anyone other than yourself you must describe your legal authority to make this request.
